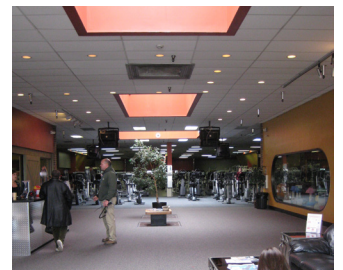


PARKVILLE FAMILY CENTER Y

ONCE A SHOPPING MALL SUBDIVIDED INTO A STRIP MALL, THE 35,000 SF SPACE WITH EXPANSIVE SKYLIGHTS AND LARGE ENTRANCE WERE PREVIOUSLY DRAPED IN ORANGE AND BROWN. THE Y OF CENTRAL MARYLAND FACED THE CHALLENGE OF TRANSFORMING THE INTERIOR TO MATCH THEIR BRAND. MARKS, THOMAS ARCHITECTS STARTED BY COMBINING A PALETTE OF SOFT YELLOWS, GREENS AND BLUES TO CREATE A CALMING ENVIRONMENT AND ANCHORING THE SKYLIGHTS BY PAINTING THEM A PALE BLUE. THE INTERIOR SIGNAGE INSTALLATION SERVED A DUAL PURPOSE OF BRINGING DOWN THE HEIGHT OF THE SPACE OVER THE GREETING AND CHECK-IN AREA AND INCORPORATING THE Y OF CENTRAL MARYLAND BRAND.
